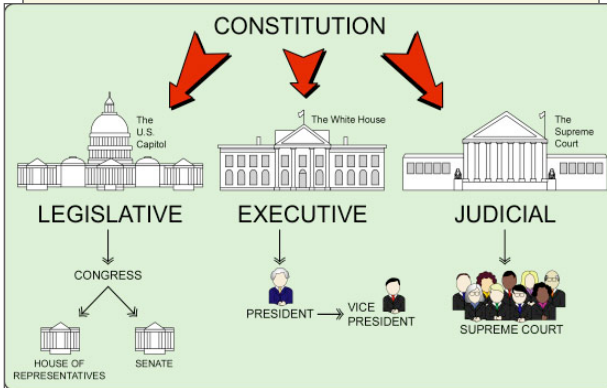




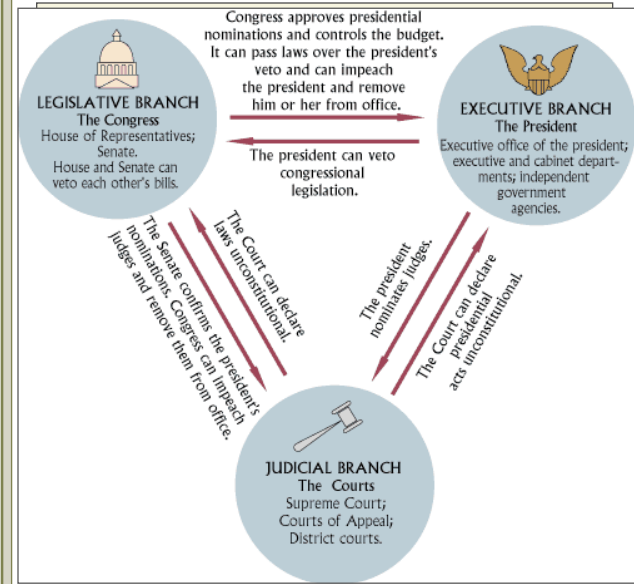
Executive
