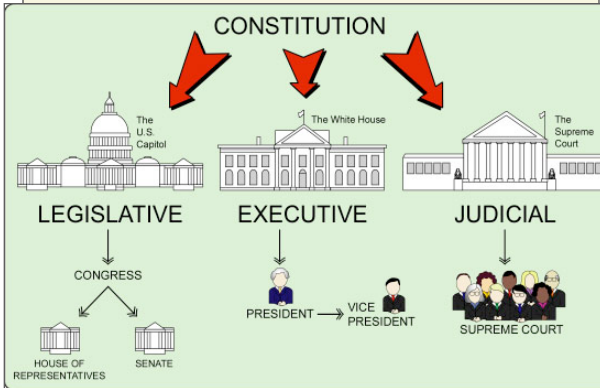




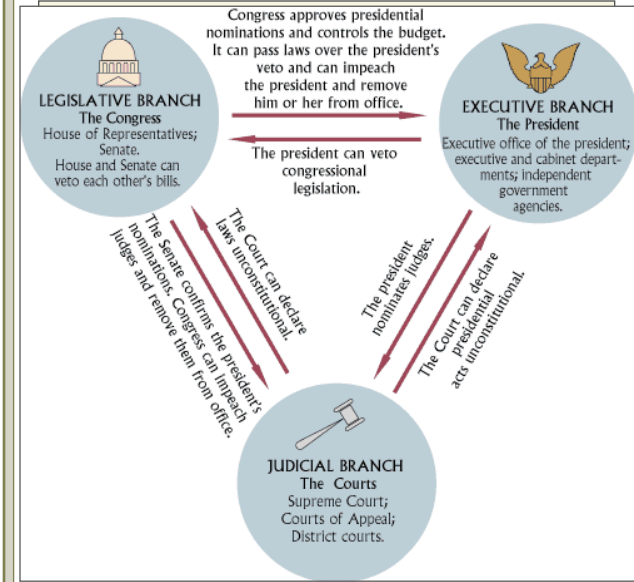
Legislative
